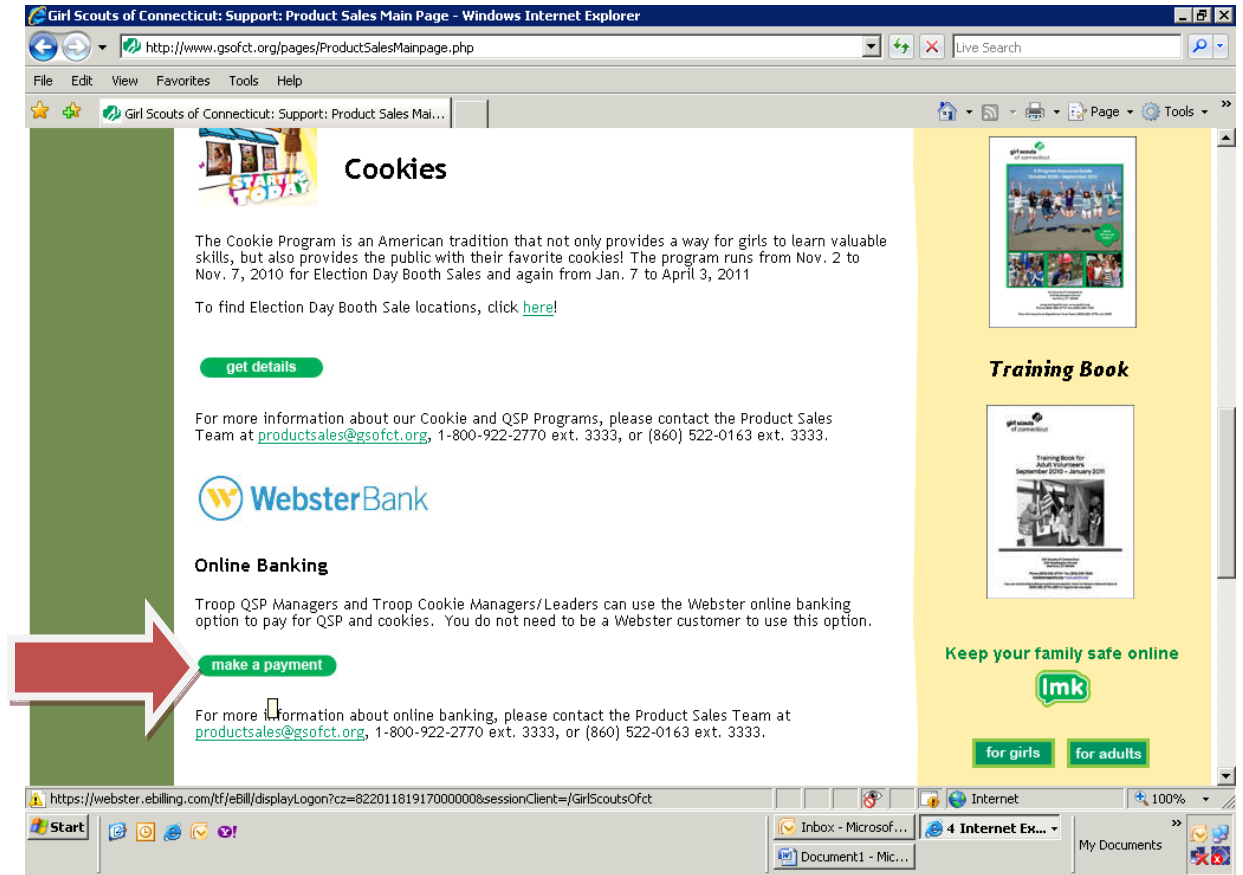

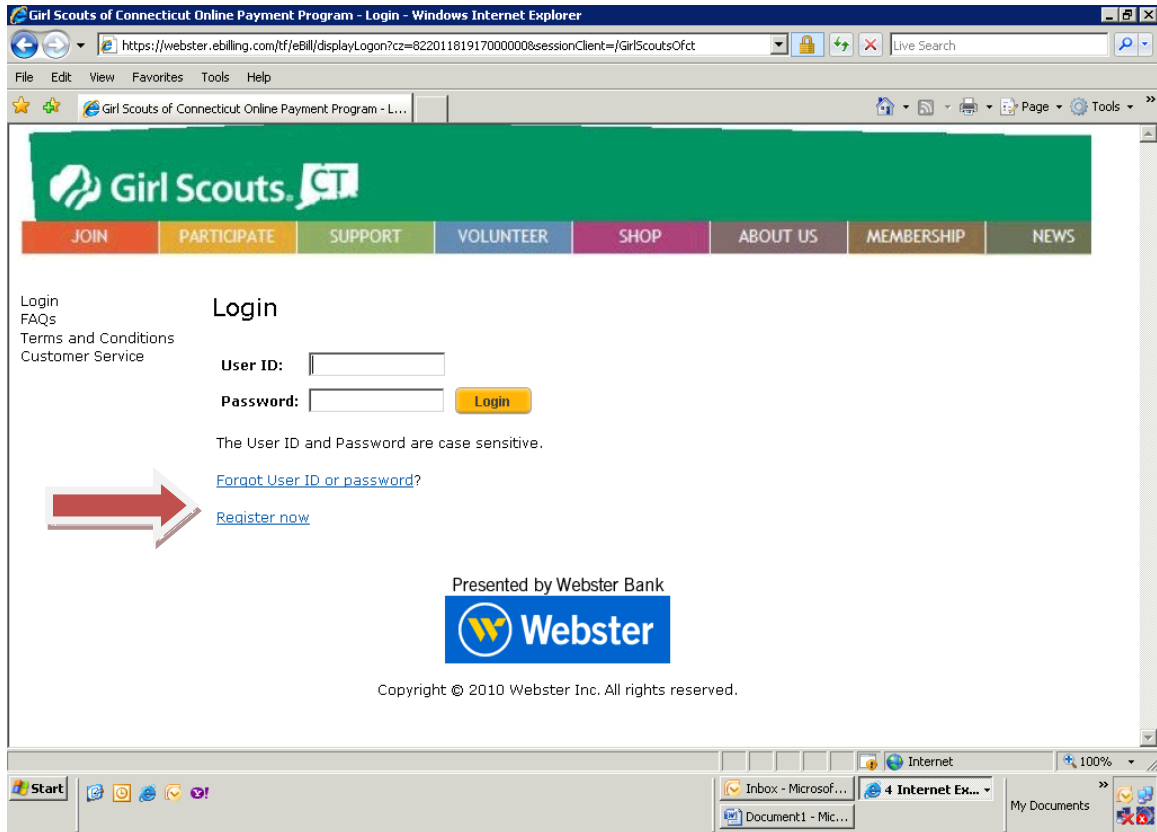

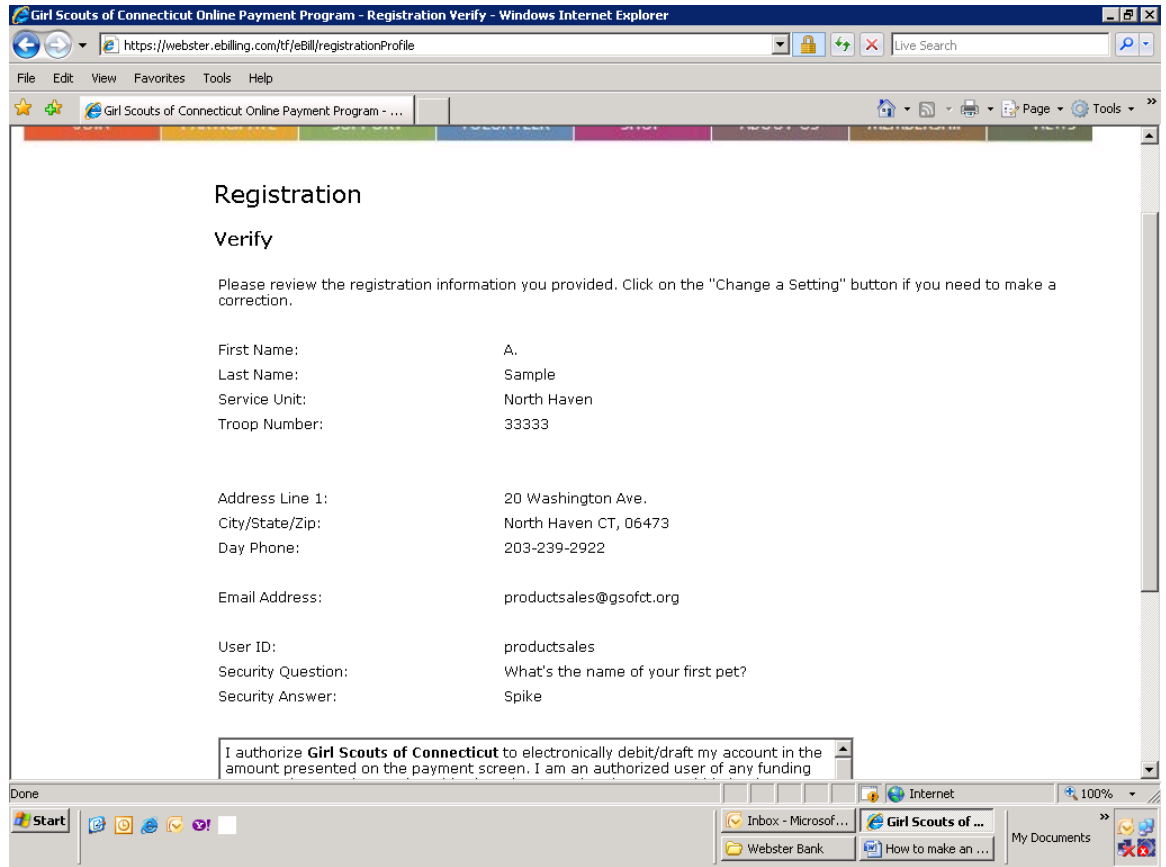

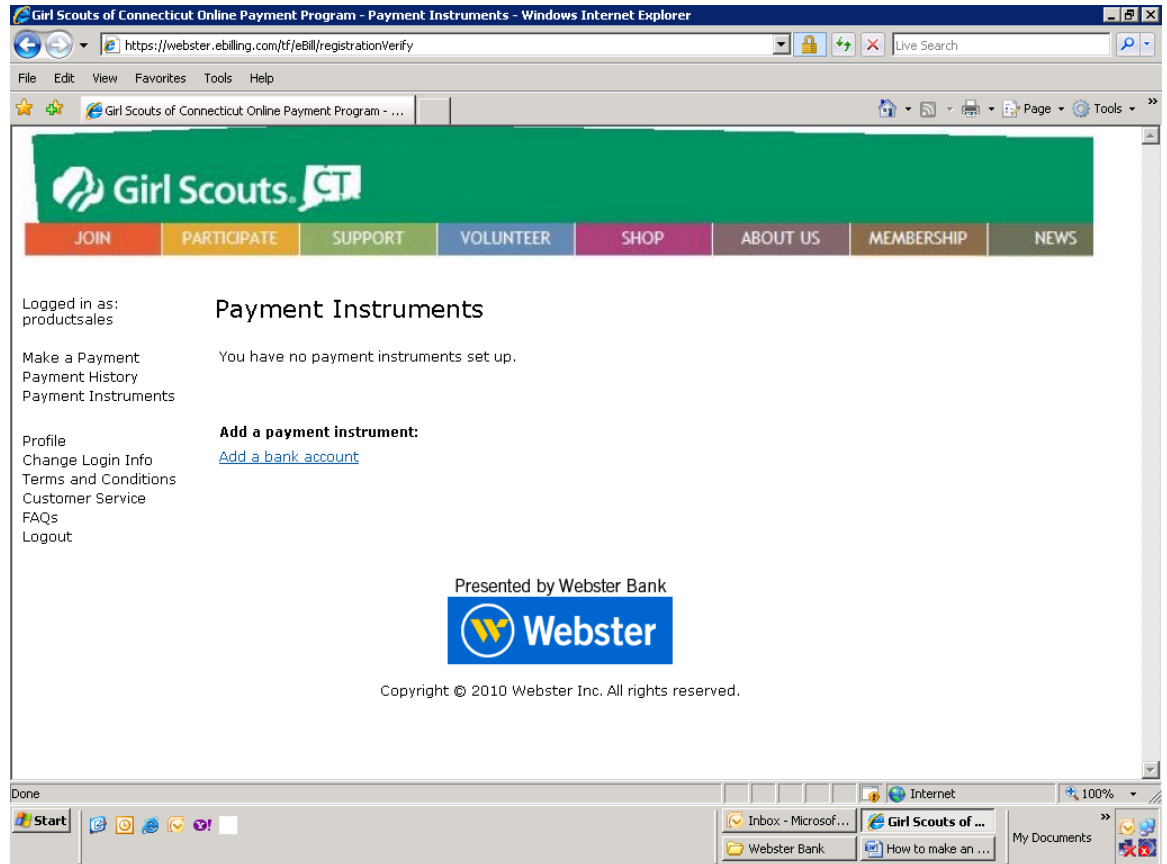

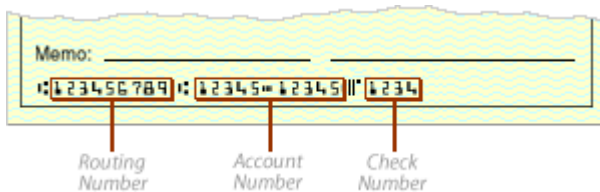


6. Click "Add a bank account".
