

# AN-SE-OX DAY CAMP

**For Girls Entering Grades 1-3 in the Fall**

## ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

### CAMPTASTIC

July 5-9; July 12-16; July 19-23; July 26-30; August 2-6; August 9-13

FEE: \$180

Camp is a fantastic place to swim, sing, play games, explore the gardens and trails, and enjoy arts and crafts. Come and learn basic skills of knot tying, campfire building, tent pitching, and nature identification. You will also have a chance to cook in the outdoors.

## TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

### BIRDS, BUTTERFLIES, AND BUMBLE BEES

July 5-16

FEE: \$325

Learn about the life cycle of butterflies. Visit our butterfly garden and make feeders for camp. Find out about all the different birds that visit Camp An-Se-Ox and hike through our bird sanctuary. As a group, build a blue bird house for camp. Then find out how bumble bees help our environment. You will still have time to swim, play games on the field, and cook outdoors.

### ART TO WEAR, ART TO SHARE

July 19-30

FEE: \$325

Decorate your clothes using tie-dye or batik; design your own hair clip or scrunchie. Wear your design in a camp fashion show. You will also make friendship bracelets and learn about S.W.A.P.s, an awesome Girl Scout tradition. Make your own autograph hound dog and have all of your new friends at camp sign it to enjoy your camp memories all year round.

### ALL THINGS SCOTTISH

August 2-13

FEE: \$325

Travel to the Scottish Highlands and play a game of golf. Listen to music and learn a Scottish folk song. Design your own tartan plaid and create your own family crest. Sample some fish and chips, scones, and shortbread and learn about Celtic art.

## For Girls Entering Grades 4-8 in the Fall

### ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

#### CAMP JOURNEY

July 5-9; July 12-16; July 19-23; July 26-30; August 2-6; August 9-13

FEE: \$180

Girls will hike, swim, cook outdoors, and make arts and crafts designed for older girls. You will also participate in non-competitive games and outdoor skills such as: tent pitching, campfire building, basic orienteering, and nature exploration.

### TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

#### THE BUTTERFLY PROJECT

July 5-16

FEE: \$325

Butterflies are beautiful and delicate creatures. Learn about their life cycle and how they survive. You will find out what they eat and make feeders for camp. Plan a butterfly party and make craft projects using the butterfly theme. You will still have time to swim, play games on the field, and cook outdoors.

#### ARTMANIA

July 19-30

FEE: \$325

This session you will learn some advanced art skills like stenciling, knitting, batik, or needlepoint. You will also create a mosaic and paint pottery. You may learn how to do glass etching and candle making. Anything is possible in this art filled camp session. Girls will also be able to participate in all of the general camp activities.

#### CLANS, TARTANS, AND BAGPIPES

August 2-13

FEE: \$325

Participate in Scottish games and design your own tartan plaid. Learn about the Scottish culture through music, dance, folk songs, and art. Cook a Scottish recipe to share with your camp mates. Search the camp for the Loch Ness Monster and turn your unit into a castle. Participate in a traditional Scottish festival.

## For Girls Entering Grades 6-8 in the Fall

### TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

#### GUARD START

July 5-16

FEE: \$360

Camp An-Se-Ox offers two water-filled weeks just for older girls. Spend extra time at the pool swimming and enjoy a floating lunch. Practice distance swimming for strength and stamina. Earn First Aid and CPR certifications. Learn basic water safety techniques and find out if you have what it takes to become a lifeguard. Lifeguard training and certification are not included. All water activities are weather dependent.

#### TWILIGHT

July 5-16

FEE: \$325

Play thunder baseball, make body glitter, and learn about nature's vampires. Prepare a vegetarian meal and play Twilight Trivia to win the "Golden Onion". Build a bat house for use at camp. Earn your Space Exploration IPA while learning about the "real" stars in our sky.

#### OUTDOOR CHALLENGE

July 19-30

FEE: \$360

If you love a challenge, this week is for you! Learn about first aid and make a first aid kit for hikers. Practice your fire building skills and cook a full meal over a fire. You will learn how to use a compass and read a map, go over hiking safety and what to do if you are lost in the woods. Learn how to build a shelter, how to build useful tools using lashing, and how to use a jack knife. You will also have time to swim every day.

#### SCRAP IT UP

July 19-30

FEE: \$325

Explore and get ideas from old scrapbooks. Then design your own personal scrapbook using pictures from home and pictures you take at camp. Personalize it with your choice of cover, stickers, and colors themes. Work on a page from the Camp An-Se-Ox scrap book. Make memory keepsakes about camp such as friendship bracelets and autograph pillows. This will be a week you will never forget!

#### INCREDIBLE EDIBLES

August 2-13

FEE: \$325

Cook it up your way. From appetizers to desserts, this session will include tips for cooking outdoors to cooking in our camp kitchen. Decorate your apron and practice your cooking skills. Choose your favorite recipes to compile a cook book for your unit. You will still have time for swimming, arts and crafts, and camp skills during this tasty session.

## Leadership Programs For Older Girls

### **LEAD (LEADERSHIP, EDUCATION, ADVENTURE, AND DEVELOPMENT) (8-12 GRADES)**

July 5-23

July 26- August 13

FEE: \$300

For girls entering grades 8-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all of the great experiences of day camp. To ensure the knowledge, tools, and skills necessary to succeed as a LEAD are provided, participants will receive Program Aide Core Training and LEAD Training. LEADs assist Unit Leaders and Program staff to involve campers in program. An application and letter of interest is required for LEAD. ### **LEAD II (9-12 GRADES)**

July 26- August 13

FEE: \$475

For girls entering grades 9-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all the great experiences of day camp. Participants will receive CPR certification and advanced outdoor specialist skills training. During the LEAD II program, applicants will spend one week as a group at Camp Timber Trails in Tolland, MA August 1-7. LEAD II applicants must have completed one session of LEAD to apply.
