ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

CAMPTASTIC

July 5-9; July 12-16; July 19-23; July 26-30

FEE: \$180

Have a taste of camp. Swim, explore the pond, enjoy arts and crafts, boat, and hike at Camp Laurel. 1-3 graders will swing on the monkey bars at the playscape and 4-8 graders will shoot at the archery range.

TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

CRAFTY'S PLACE

July 5-16

FEE: \$325

ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

HORSE FAN I

July 5-9; July 12-16; July 19-23; July 26-30

FEE: \$280

This starter horse program is for the camper who really loves horses and hasn't had the opportunity to ride. This horseback riding program is focused on basic riding techniques, safety, and equipment. Campers will learn to mount, dismount, and ride the horse at a walking pace. Come to Laurel Stables for three beginner riding lessons.

Entering Grades 4-8 continued...

TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

HORSE FAN II

July 5-16; July 19-30

FEE: \$425

This starter horse program is for the camper who really loves horses, but does not ride very often. This horseback riding program is focused on basic riding techniques, safety, and equipment. Campers will learn to mount, dismount, and ride the horse at a walk's pace. Come to Laurel Stables for six beginner riding lessons. During this two-week session, campers will participate in at least one trail ride through camp!

Leadership Programs For Older Girls

LEAD (LEADERSHIP, EDUCATION, ADVENTURE, AND DEVELOPMENT) (8-12 GRADES)

July 5-23

FEE: \$300

For girls entering grades 8-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all of the great experiences of day camp. To ensure the knowledge, tools, and skills necessary to succeed as a LEAD are provided, participants will receive Program Aide Core Training and LEAD Training. LEADs assist Unit Leaders and Program staff to involve campers in program. An application and letter of interest is required for LEAD. LEAD II (9-12 GRADES)

July 12-31

FEE: \$475

For girls entering grades 9-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all the great experiences of day camp. Participants will receive CPR certification and advanced outdoor specialist skills training. During the LEAD II program, applicants will spend one week as a group at Laurel Resident Camp in Lebanon, CT July 25-31. LEAD II applicants must have completed one session of LEAD to apply. An application, letter of reference, and a resume is required for LEAD II.
