## ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

### CAMPTASTIC

July 19-23; July 26-30; August 2-6; August 9-13

FEE: \$195

## ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

### TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

#### PUPPET MASTER

July 19-30

FEE: \$350

## Leadership Programs For Older Girls

### **DARE TO DO IT (8-12 GRADES)**

August 9-13

FEE: \$285

You will also canoe and funyak on the lake, and then work on hiking, orienteering skills, and outdoor cooking. This session is for the girl who loves the outdoors and is up for a challenge!

### **LEAD (LEADERSHIP, EDUCATION, ADVENTURE, AND DEVELOPMENT) (8-12 GRADES)**

July 19- August 6

FEE: \$300

For girls entering grades 8-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all of the great experiences of day camp. To ensure the knowledge, tools, and skills necessary to succeed as a LEAD are provided, participants will receive Program Aide Core Training and LEAD Training. LEADs assist Unit Leaders and Program staff to involve campers in program. An application and letter of interest is required for LEAD. ### **LEAD II (9-12 GRADES)**

July 19- August 6

FEE: \$475

For girls entering grades 9-12 who are ready to take on a leadership role helping younger girls enjoy all the great experiences of day camp. Participants will receive CPR certification and advanced outdoor specialist skills training. During the LEAD II program, applicants will spend one week as a group at Laurel Resident Camp in Lebanon, CT July 25-31. LEAD II applicants must have completed one session of LEAD to apply.
