BIKING RIGHT ALONG

August 1-14

FEE: \$725

FEE: \$725

Leadership Programs For Older Girls

LEADER-IN-TRAINING (LIT) (13-14 YEARS OLD)

August 1-14

FEE: \$695

This is the first phase of our extensive leadership program. The LIT focus is on group dynamic, diversity training, positive role-modeling, and fun! Girls will have the chance to participate in camp activities they love like archery, boating, challenge course, cookouts, campfires, while learning the skills needed to build quality camp leaders. Girls will have the opportunity to earn service hours and to give back to the camp community by planning and facilitating an in-camp project. Not only will you make friends and camp memories but this is the first step on the road to camp counseling.

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT) (15 AND OLDER)

July 18- August 14

FEE: \$650

This is phase two of our leadership program. Girls participating must have successfully completed the LIT or LEAD program, or have letters of recommendations. Girls must be at least 15. In this program girls will continue to build upon the skills they have gained in past leadership programs or experiences. CITs will focus on girl planning, diversity training, and program design. They will learn many of the skills necessary to make the decision to become a camp counselor. CITs will create an afternoon program for younger campers and have plenty of opportunities to teach, lead, and learn. CITs will be required to design and complete a Leadership Camp Service Project. This program is a 4-week program. CITs will go home after two weeks and return for the last two weeks.

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING II (CIT II) (16 AND OLDER)

July 5-31

FEE: \$550

This program is an extension of the CIT program. It is by invitation only, and participants must have documented successful completion and evaluation from CIT program. Entry in this program requires an application, references, and phone interview. This is a 4-week continued leadership program with the possibility of additional 2-week invitational apprenticeship. This invitational apprenticeship is not guaranteed. Decisions are made solely at the discretion of the Camp Director based on the evaluations from the leadership directors.

Leadership Programs continued...

WRANGLER-IN-TRAINING (WIT)

(16 AND OLDER)

July 5-31

FEE: \$750

This is phase one of our riding leadership program. Girls participating must have documented riding experience and a letter of recommendation. All applicants must be 16 by the start of the program. Girls will continue to build upon the skills they have gained in past stable and riding experience. This program will focus on girl planning, diversity training, barn management and riding program design. They will learn many of the skills necessary to become a camp counselor in the riding program at Camp Timber Trails. WITs will assist in creating additional riding programs for younger campers and have plenty of opportunities to teach, lead, and learn. You will have time to create a portfolio of information, lessons, and instructional hours to take with you.

This is a 4-week leadership program. For the right candidate it holds the possibility of an additional 2-week invitational apprenticeship. This invitational apprenticeship is not guaranteed. Decisions are made solely at the discretion of the Camp Director and the evaluations from both the leadership director and Barn Directors. Application is required, along with references and an interview. This is a leadership program and horseback riding is not a guarantee. Wranglers will go home after two weeks on Saturday and return on Sunday.

WRANGLER-IN-TRAINING II (WIT II)

(17 AND OLDER)

July 5-31

FEE: \$650

This program is an extension of the WIT program. It is by invitation only. It requires application, references, and an interview. Preliminary requirement is successful completion and evaluation from WIT or reference letters. This is a 4-week continued leadership program with the possibility of an additional 2-week invitational apprenticeship. This invitational apprenticeship is not guaranteed. Decisions are made solely at the discretion of the Camp Director and based on the evaluations from the Barn Director. Application is required, along with references, and an interview. This is a leadership program and horseback riding is not a guaranteed. Wranglers will go home after two weeks on Saturday and return on Sunday.
