<p>d Similarities & Differences — \$5.00 For Grades K-1, Girl Scout Daisies 10:00 — 11:00 a.m.</p> <p>How are members of the same group of animals similar and different from each other? Learning to classify living things is an important early-elementary science skill. Young students engage in up-close examinations of crabs, fish, turtles and mollusks. They use their senses of sight and touch to describe similarities and differences in shape, texture, color and more. There's nothing like live animals to spark inquiry in young scientists!</p>	<p>b j Life Between the Tides — \$5.00 Grades 3-4: Girl Scout Brownies and Juniors; 1:30—2:30 p.m.</p> <p>Imagine living in a place that gets flooded every day! That's the challenge faced by the resilient animals of Long Island Sound's intertidal zone. Read tide charts and learn how the moon influences the rise and fall of the tides. Meet and touch crabs, mollusks and gastropods, use a field guide to identify them, and employ observation skills to explain how these animals adapt to the daily & seasonal changes in their environment.</p>
<p>d b Life Cycles — \$5.00 For Grades 1-2. Girl Scout Daisies, Brownies; 11:30 a.m.—12:15 p.m.</p> <p>Every animal changes during the course of its life, but some more than others. Students make discoveries about life cycles by examining live animals and the shells, cocoons and other artifacts they leave behind as they grow. In this hands-on experience, students are introduced to different types of animals and classify and sequence their life-cycle patterns. They also learn key words related to life cycles, including egg, larva, adult</p>	<p>j Behind-the-Scenes: Species in Our Own Backyard — \$5.00 Grades 3-5: Girl Scout Brownies and Juniors; 10:00 - 11:00 a.m.</p> <p>In the company of an Aquarium educator, your scouts will see The Maritime Aquarium as never before. Become scientists as you cruise aboard our research vessel on this one-hour, 45-minute cruise. Use sampling techniques such as water chemistry and plankton tows, and sort through a bio-dredge sample as we make observations above and below the water. Scouts will help the crew record this data, to become part of our biodiversity database. We'll also keep an eye out for winter birds and seals, which can be spotted on the Sound this time of year!
