

# 100th Anniversary Art Exhibits



## Service Unit Art Exhibits: important dates and information

**January 15:** Contact Ellyn Savard with date and location of your SU art exhibit.

**March 1– May 12:** Hold your SU art exhibit. Choose two pieces to be displayed at the 100th Jubilee on May 19.

**April 15 (or before):** As soon as you are sure your SU will be submitting two pieces to the Jubilee, please reserve your space by contacting Ellyn Savard.

**May 9–16:** Deliver two art pieces to one of the following Service Centers: North Haven, Hartford, or Bridgeport

**May 19th:** Visit the Jubilee Art Exhibit held at the Durham Fairground's Cow Palace. Pick up artwork after 6:00 p.m. at the Cow Palace

### Parameters for artwork submitted to Jubilee exhibit:

**2-dimensional art:** No larger than 16x20" and ready to hang; if framed, use plexiglass, not glass.

**3-dimensional art:** Must be submitted with its own base or be able to stand on its own; must be able to be carried by one person; smaller pieces will be displayed on a table with other pieces

**Who:** Service Units will hold art exhibits in their areas based on the theme *What it Means to be a Girl Scout*. All Girl Scouts in Connecticut are invited to contribute a piece of artwork in the media of their choice. SUs will choose one-two pieces (suggested: one from a Daisy or Brownie and one from a Junior-Ambassador) to be displayed at the 100<sup>th</sup> Jubilee on May 19, 2012 at the Durham Fairgrounds.

**When:** Service Unit Art Exhibit dates: any time between March 1 – May 12, 2012; it is suggested (although not required) that SUs hold their exhibits in conjunction with the Promise Circle and/or a presentation by the Traveling Juliettes. Speak to your community about possible locations including your Town Hall, Historical Society, schools, community center, library, local gallery, etc. The exhibit may be short or long term depending on your host site's availability. Invite local dignitaries and the media to your exhibit.  
Delivery dates for two SU pieces for the Jubilee: May 9 – May 16, 2012.

**Important:** As soon as you are sure your Service Unit will be submitting two pieces to the Jubilee Art Show, reserve your space by contacting Ellyn Savard at [esavard@gsofct.org](mailto:esavard@gsofct.org) or 800-922-2770, ext. 3018.

**Where:** Deliver your Service Unit's two entries to Jubilee Program Staff at the North Haven Service Center, Bridgeport Service Center, or Hartford Service Center.  
Pick-up dates: please take art home the day of the 100th Jubilee after 6:00 p.m. from the Durham Fairgrounds Cow Palace.  
Girl Scouts of Connecticut may not be held responsible for any unclaimed pieces or damage or loss of artwork.

**What:** **Media** includes watercolor, oils, pastels, chalk, pen and ink, photography, pottery or ceramics, woodworking, decoupage, sculpture, recycled art, paper crafts, collage, poster art, scrap-booking, weaving, fabric art, sewing, jewelry or other.

**Requirements for artwork submitted to 100th Jubilee:** For their local show, SUs may set guidelines of their own, however, please adhere to the following parameters for the pieces submitted to the Jubilee art exhibit:

#### **2-dimensional art**

- Size limit of outside dimensions: 16" x 20"
- Pieces may be framed or unframed
- Framed artwork must be wired for hanging; use plexiglass rather than glass for ease of transporting and to avoid breakage
- Unframed pieces must be mounted on foam core or matted, or otherwise stiff enough to hang from a hook or rest on s-hooks without curling.

#### **Sculpture or other 3-dimensional art**

- Floor sculpture must be submitted with its own base or be able to stand on its own
- Tabletop sculpture will be displayed among other sculptures on a table; must be submitted with pedestal base or be able to stand on its own
- Although there is no size restriction per se, all sculptures must be able to be carried by one average-sized person.

#### **Other 3-Dimensional Art**

Fabric art, jewelry, sewing projects, mosaics or collage etc, should be submitted with own display method.

If 2-dimensional, it should be no larger than 16" x 20" and either able to hang on a hook, or mounted and able to sit on s-hooks.
