## *Core Leadership Requirements*

**Complete steps 1-3 of the Core Leadership Requirements prior to initial troop/group meeting.**



### Volunteer Application Process

- Submit a Volunteer Application.
- Successfully complete a background screening.
- Provide 3 personal, non-related references.
- Enroll as a member in Girl Scouts of the USA by submitting an Adult Member Registration Form along with the \$12.00 annual membership dues.
- GSUSA Membership Dues of \$12.00 goes directly to the national organization to pay for accidental insurance covering participation in Girl Scout approved activities, program research and resources, training and services to councils.

### Girl Scouting 101

- This GSUSA online training introduces new volunteers to Girl Scouts.
- Topics include the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, the Girl Scout National Program Portfolio, cookie sales, safety guidelines, and much much more.
- This online training needs to be completed within two (2) weeks from receipt of the online link.

### Girl Scouts of Connecticut Orientation

- This face-to-face meeting will be with your Service Unit Orientation Volunteer or with the Membership and Marketing Manager from your area.
- This meeting is designed to review the Girl Scout structure, policies and procedures, and answer any questions you may have with regard to general Girl Scout practices.

### Basic Leader Training

- This training provides leaders with tools for planning and carrying out troop/group programs.
- Topics discussed include safety awareness, group management skills, meeting planning, programming ideas and ways to keep the girls involved in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.
- Basic Leader Training needs to be completed within three (3) months of starting your troop/group.
