



Constance Patch Program

This program engages girls in learning about Girl Scouts of Connecticut camps. Participation and visitation to Girl Scout properties allows girls to collect all of the Caterpillar segments.

The requirements are as follows:

- 1) Site registration is required.
- 2) Girls will **DISCOVER** the history of camp, meet the camp mascot, and learn about some of the traditions of the camp and property through a letterboxing discovery program or through a scavenger hunt program at the camp property.
- 3) Girls will **CONNECT** with the camp/property by writing their thoughts and comments in a "Reflection Journal" and answering the question "What did you do today?"
- 4) Girls will **TAKE ACTION** by working on a service project on the camp property. For example, girls can collect wood for a functional wood pile, provide tinder and kindling to each camp site, clean and dust a camp building, or a larger project approved by the property department. Please contact Samantha Goodman in the Property Department.
- 5) Girls will **EXPLORE** one area of healthy living as part of the Girl Scout Healthy Initiative. For example, girls can use troop sports equipment to get some exercise on the play field, take a hike through the property, learn about healthy eating by making smoothies, or by making a healthy snack to share.
