Purpose: Showcase all the fun things Groton CT has to offer Girl Scouts and to teach girls about marine observation.

- Table must be covered with a green or white tablecloth.
- Print or Stencil writing when possible.
- No food or drink in public view.
- One adult and one girl must be at the display at all times.
- People staffing displays are encouraged to be in Girl Scout apparel and to wear G.S. pins.
- There will be no charge for entering a S.U. display.
- No MEAs.
- All those staffing a showcase display must be event ticket holders.
- **All applications must be submitted by December 5, 2011.**
- More details for the day will be sent with your confirmation .
- Materials must be dropped off prior to event and taken home at the conclusion.
