

Do a Good Turn Daily patch

Description - “Do a good turn daily.” Since 1912 Girl Scouts have been aspiring to this slogan! While working on this patch you will make a positive impact in people’s lives and ultimately make the world a better place.

What’s a “good turn?” - It is something you do to make a difference without being asked and without expecting anything in return. A daily good turn doesn’t have to be the same everyday and it can be big or small. Always keep your eyes open for an opportunity to be helpful and make the world a better place.



How to earn it:

Step 1 – Do a good turn daily everyday for four months. If you’d like, you can use the Good Turn Daily calendar found at gsofct.org.

Step 2 – Recognize or thank at least four others for their good turns. They don’t have to be Girl Scouts. Hand them a Kindness Coin or Card. Find Printable cards and directions for kindness coins online too!

Step 3 – Reflect. At the end of four months, hold a discussion, day of service, or ceremony focused on what you did, and how it made you feel. Were there changes within you or others?

When to earn it: Remember, while you can start this at any time, the four months between October 31 and March is recommended. Use Girl Scout Week for reflection.

Hold the door for someone
