Contest Rules

- Contest is open to Girl Scouts of Connecticut youth members (K-12).
- Entries must be youth members' original work. No clip art or downloads allowed.
- Complete the application (p.2 below) and use the Patch Design Template to submit art.
- The design should include text identifying the "Community" AND "GSOFCT."
- Each design should celebrate the look or landmarks of your GSOFCT Community (SouthWest, NorthWest, South Central, NorthEast, or SouthEast).
- All patch designs must be submitted to Customer Care by November 16, 2025 by email at customercare@gsfct.org.
- GSOFCT staff will select up to 3 designs for each Community to be voted on by members during the designated voting period. Each of these designers will receive a special Girl Scout surprise gift!
- Selected designs will be shared on GSOFCT social media accounts the week of Dec. 7, 2025, where voting will take place. Five winners total (one for each Community Patch).
- Final designs may be edited to meet vendor criteria. Due to editing and actual patch size, winning designs may not appear in exactly the same size or coloring as the original.
- Winning designs will be featured on one of the five Council's Own Community Patches that will be worn by thousands of Girl Scouts across Connecticut!


