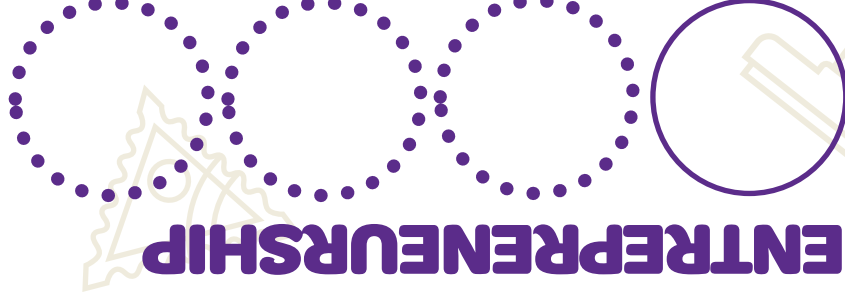
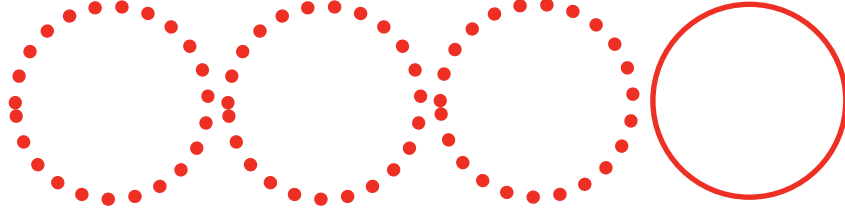


PILLARS
